

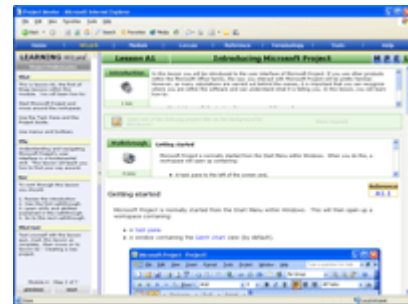

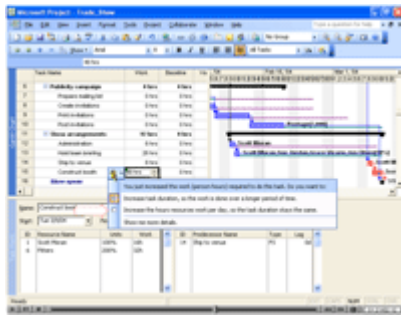
## Even simpler to use

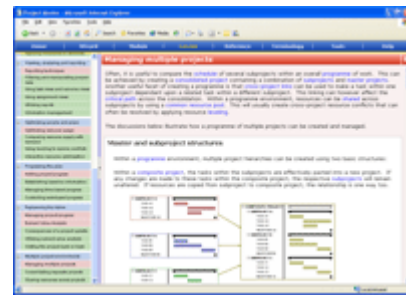

## Improved flexibility

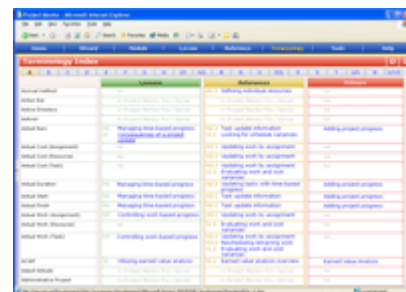
Enhanced flexibility lets users learn when and how they want.
